



GP TAKORADI TERMINAL



The GP Takoradi Terminal is a Fuel Offloading Facility situated at the Ghana Ports and Harbour Authority (GPHA) Port of Takoradi. This terminal is one part of Genser’s comprehensive fuel supply and logistics system.

Operations of the GP Takoradi Terminal revolve around:

- 1) Unloading of LPG from an offshore import vessel at the Takoradi Port unto Bulk Road Vehicles (BRVs);
- 2) Loading of Bulk Road Vehicles (BRVs) via a Fuel offloading skid at the port; and
- 3) Transportation /haulage of LPG from the Takoradi Port to the Kojokrom Storage Facility and power plant sites.

Currently, 10,000 Metric Tons of LPG are imported at a time. The import vessel anchors offshore at the Takoradi port every twenty eight (28) days. LPG is then offloaded simultaneously into four (4) BRVs via the offloading skid.
